



ABOUT THE SALARY SURVEY

Welcome to the 22nd edition of the annual Robert Walters Salary Survey. As the first recruitment company to produce a comprehensive overview of global salaries and recruitment trends across the world, we are pleased to share the latest edition with you.

Our Salary Survey is based on the analysis of permanent, interim, and contract placements made across each of our countries and recruitment disciplines during 2020, and it also includes our predictions for the year ahead.

METHODOLOGY

The Robert Walters data analyst team reviewed over 100,000 roles advertised in the United Kingdom over a 12-month period to calculate the average of each role in the survey, as well as the upper and lower salary limits. Where distinctions have been found, permanent salaries are categorised by company size: medium enterprise (headcounts from 50 to 250) and large enterprise (headcounts of 250 and above).

Salaries have also been provided for most prominent professional roles in small, upcoming businesses (headcounts below 50). For niche areas with less salary data available, the salary ranges have been provided, omitting the average, and in some cases, the year-on-year growth.

UK 2020 V 2021

2020

2020 has been a year of upheaval and disruption, with the COVID-19 pandemic having a profound effect on the market. Added to that, people's uncertainty around Brexit has further compounded uncertainty.

Whilst Brexit indecision dominated the first few months of 2020, the shock of COVID-19 hit home among companies and professionals alike in Q2.

However, from the summer onwards, there have been some signs of readjustment on a number of scales, aided by the UK's highly skilled and adaptable workforce and the speed and ease at which many firms have been able to transition to remote working.

IMPLICATIONS FOR UK BUSINESSES

In spite of the broader market challenges, there was positivity in some sectors; however, that was countered by huge difficulties in others, such as retail, leisure, travel, and hospitality.

Areas that have done notably well out of the disruption have been those aligned to technology, supply chain & logistics, healthcare, and financial services – particularly in areas that rely on volatility such as hedge funds, broker-dealers, and the trading arms of investment banks.

Judging by previous market cycles, senior professionals possessing expertise in restructuring and turnarounds will be in high demand as the UK initially emerges from its recessionary market.

Experienced individuals who are able to communicate effectively to provide training and advice to more junior staff will also be highly valued as the markets begin to pick up and transition into a growth cycle.

SKILLS IN DEMAND

Whilst the initial hiring focus will primarily be on senior talent who possess strong communication skills, roles for junior staff and foot-in-door individuals will also emerge as demand cascades through sector-by-sector.

It is anticipated that some of the changes incorporated into workplaces as a result of COVID-19 in 2020 will become established in day-to-day working environments going forward.

With this in mind, we expect ways of working to change in a number of sectors, with an element of remote working continuing to be incorporated in some industries and sectors.

EMPLOYEE VALUE PROPOSITION

After the shock of Q2 and the restrictions put in place, businesses quickly turned to niche skill sets, with small and hard-to-find talent pools, to help to offset the impact of COVID-19, with demand increasing as the year went on. This heightened competition to attain the same kind of skill sets among companies placed a clear focus on employee value propositions – or, more simply put, their benefits package – and the need to be considered an employer of choice in the year ahead.

ATTRACTING AND RETAINING BEST TALENT IN 2021

2020 has played a fundamental role in equalising the relationship between an organisation and its people, with many companies prioritising future of work programmes and employee retention schemes.

Clear and compelling value propositions that are inclusive for employees from all backgrounds will be a clear focus in 2021 in order for organisations to retain existing staff and to attract the best talent in the market to fill new, specialised roles which current skillsets cannot fulfil.

Of the businesses surveyed, 86% are offering enhanced employee value propositions within their 2021 recruitment strategies, from entry level through to management and director level.

Employers need to consider employee values that resonate with staff in 2021 and beyond, and should not assume that the traditional benefits offered will be what employees will look for in the future. This will not only attract the best talent, but will retain and motivate existing talent.

PRIORITISING MENTAL HEALTH IN THE WORKPLACE

Mental health and wellbeing strategies will continue to be a major priority for employers, with ‘good work-life balance’ ranked top of the list of what is valued most in employers by professionals. With remote working likely to play a role in many sectors and positions for the coming year, companies are evolving their employee wellbeing strategies to ensure maximum job satisfaction when working outside the usual office environment.




